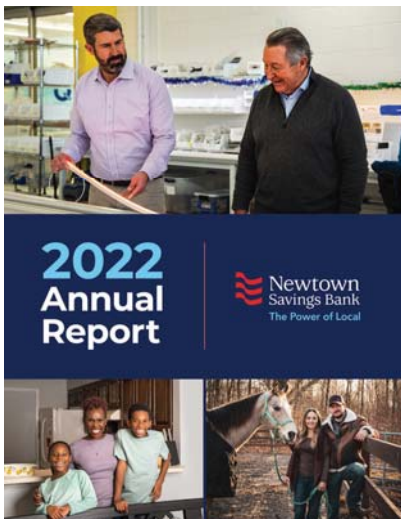
New Corporators Elected
